

# PACKING FOR CAMP

We recommend a **duffel bag** be used to transport your child's belongings to camp. A suggested packing list can be found below. Campers will be very active during the week. You don't need to purchase new clothing for America's Camp – your child's regular summertime apparel will be fine. In addition, America's Camp will provide two pairs of shorts, two t-shirts, a sweatshirt and pair of sweatpants, and a baseball cap.

- Pack for a full week. There will be no regular laundry service at camp. Remember that there will be days where your child will be changing in and out of clothes during the day, depending on the various activities (land sports, pool, lake, etc.).
- *Mark all items, either with name tapes or with the camper's name written in permanent marker.*
- Blankets will be available at camp. **Campers will need to bring their own pillows and sheets.** Many campers choose to bring their own blankets or comforter.
- Bring essential equipment for sports you plan to play (baseball glove, tennis racquet, etc.)
- Campers are asked to not bring expensive items to camp, as we would not want anyone to lose or break anything of great value.
- Electronic games and portable audio players (MP3, I-Pod, boom box, radio) may only be used on the bus ride and in the cabin.
